Any report you make can be treated with strict confidentiality.

What should I report?

Examples of the type of conduct you can report to us:

- [Abandonment or sudden closure](https://guidance.sra.org.uk/consumers/problems/fraud-dishonesty/abandonment-closure/) of a firm or [sole practitioner](https://guidance.sra.org.uk/consumers/using-solicitor/legal-jargon-explained#sole-practitioner)
- [Arrest, charge or conviction](https://guidance.sra.org.uk/consumers/problems/fraud-dishonesty/arrest-charge-conviction/) of a person regulated by us
