

## **Independent regulation**

To secure the independent regulation envisaged by the Legal Services Act 2007, there must be adequate separation between an approved regulator's representative functions and its regulatory functions.

The Act places a duty on the <u>Legal Services Board</u> [<u>https://legalservicesboard.org.uk/]</u>(LSB) to make rules to ensure adequate separation.

The Internal Governance Rules 2009 were made by the LSB on 9 December 2009. They are binding on the Law Society, as approved regulator, and on the SRA as the Society's regulatory arm.
